- Lunches, snacks, and drinks
- Personal expenses (laundry, phone calls, travel insurance, souvenirs, etc.)

NOTE: Participants will need to reserve and pay for their own roundtrip airline tickets personally. Prior to making final reservations, participants must consult with Dr. Klassen for approval of the itinerary.

# Payment plan:

- Payment for the tour will be made directly to "TUTKU Educational Travel" (www.tutkutours.com).
- A **deposit of \$200** is due December 1, 2022.
- The remaining **full payment** is due February 13, 2023.
- For both payments, a link will be provided to make payment via secure credit card transaction.

## **Refund Policy:**

- The initial deposit of \$200 (due December 1, 2022) is refundable until February 13, 2023.
- The remaining full payment is refundable after payment according to the following schedule:
  - o 90-60 days prior to departure: 100% refundable
  - o 59-45 days prior to departure: 75% refundable
  - o 44-30 days prior to departure: 50% refundable
  - o 29-15 days prior to departure: 25% refundable
  - o Within 14 days of departure: 0% refundable

#### **Travel Insurance:**

- It is the responsibility of each trip participant to consult with his medical insurance carrier to determine whether his insurance policy is sufficient for the full duration of his time while in Turkey and Greece.
- It is the responsibility of each trip participant to purchase any additional coverage needed.

## **Itinerary changes:**

- In exceptional circumstances the in-country trip itinerary is subject to change. Such circumstances may include mechanical problems during travel, weather at site locations, security concerns, or crowd considerations at the sites.
- It is the responsibility of each participant to arrange and pay for his own airline tickets to Istanbul for the start of the tour and from Athens at the end (see the detailed itinerary). Each participant must provide Dr. Klassen (bklassen@tms.edu) with a copy of the itinerary as soon as it has been finalized.
- All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. The Master's Seminary is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.
- It remains the responsibility of each participant to rearrange his international flight details if they are changed by the airlines.
- If an airline itinerary change necessitates extra overnights in either Istanbul or Athens, each traveler is responsible for the added costs.

# **Covid-19 vaccination and testing:**

Many of the Covid-19 era restrictions have been lifted, but it is difficult to project the state of things 7 months from today. At this point it is likely that Covid-19 vaccinations will <u>not</u> be required for U.S. citizens for entry into Turkey or Greece, or for return back into the United States. However, for students of different nationalities this may be different. In particular, if you reside in the United States under a student visa status, you may be required to have an up-to-date Covid-19 vaccination in order to return to the U.S. after vising Turkey and Greece.

It is the applicant's responsibility to research these restrictions. However, the tour leader will provide regular updates on the Covid-19 requirements throughout the trip's planning stages.
