# Payment plan:

- Payment for the tour will be made directly to "TUTKU Educational Travel" (www.tutkutours.com).
- A deposit of \$200/person is due to TUTKU on December 1, 2023.
- The remaining **full payment of \$3790/person** is due to TUTKU on February 12, 2024.
- TMS friends (non students or alumni and their wives) will pay a remaining amount of \$200/person in Turkey, for extra costs associated with the trip.
- For both payments, a link will be provided to make payment via secure credit card transaction.

## **Refund Policy:**

- The initial deposit of \$200 (due December 1, 2023) is refundable until February 11, 2024.
- The remaining full payment is refundable after payment according to the following schedule:
  - o 89-60 days prior to departure: 100% refundable
  - o 59-45 days prior to departure: 75% refundable

44-30 days prior to departure: 50% refundable
29-15 days prior to departure: 25% refundable
Within 14 days of departure: 0% refundable

# **Travel Insurance:**
