2024 TMS Turkey & Greece Study Trip—Scholarship Funds

Generous donors have provided funds to cover between 30% and 60% of the total cost of the trip for residential, full-time BTh and MDiv students (the scholarships are not available to distance-location BTh or MDiv students). Full-time ThM students at any point in their studies also qualify for this scholarship. This means the entire study trip to Turkey and Greece could cost as little as \$1600/person total!

Minimum requirements to receive a scholarship:

- Current full-time MDiv and BTh students of The Master's Seminary, studying at the LA campus. Current ThM students of The Master's Seminary, studying on campus or from a distance.
- Priority will be given to students who have completed 50 credit hours or more of the BTh/MDiv curriculum by the end of the spring 2023 semester. Students who have applied for scholarship funding with less than then 50 completed credit hours by the end of the spring 2024 semester will be considered for scholarship funding if there are sufficient funds remaining.
- GPA at 3.00 or above.
- Completion of the scholarship application.

How do you apply for a scholarship?

- 1. Complete the TMS Turkey/Greece Study Trip General Application and submit it to the trip leader, Dr. Brad Klassen (bklassen@tms.edu), by November 25, 2023.
- 2. Complete the TMS Turkey/Greece Study Trip Scholarship Application (below) **by November 25** and send it also to Dr. Brad Klassen (<u>bklassen@tms.edu</u>).
- 3. You will be informed of a decision on your scholarship application by the end of the day on November 30.
- 4. The trip deposit of \$200.00/person will need to be paid by the student by 5pm on December 1, 2023. The payment must be made by credit card to the tour agency administrating the trip itinerary (Tutku Educational Tours). Instructions regarding this deposit will be provided.
- 5. The scholarship amount will then be applied to the remaining balance, due February 12, 2024.

Clarifications:

- **These scholarship funds are only for TMS students and NOT for their wives, as important as it is for a wife to join her husband for a trip like this.
- **Scholarship funds WILL NOT be deposited into your student account. They cannot be used to cover the \$200 deposit. They will be paid directly to the tour company, TUTKU Educational Tours.
- **Scholarship funds WILL be applied to the amount that is due for the final payment of the trip cost, which is due February 12, 2024
