## 2025 TMS Israel Trip—Tuition Scholarship Funds

Dr. Grisanti offers two courses—2 credit hours each—related to the TMS Israel trip. BI652 meets on Wednesday mornings (8:00-9:50 am) and provides great preparation for the Israel trip. The course begins with some lecture based on course note but the bulk of the course involves instruction using PP presentations for each region of Israel. BI653 is a course connected with the Israel trip. It requires some pre-trip Bible reading and map work. Both courses are good electives courses to take. Any spring tuition scholarships awarded may be used for BI 652 spring semester course as part of your regular course load. Tuition scholarships are not awarded for summer school courses. The IRS does not allow the school to offer academic scholarships for summer courses.

#### 2025 TMS Israel Trip—Direct Scholarship Funds

Each year we depend on the generosity of donors to provide funds that assist TMS students to better understand their Bible by going on a study trip to Israel. God has blessed us with funds that enable us to offer **several \$2500.00 Israel trip scholarships.** 

## Minimum requirements to receive a scholarship:

- Active/Current student at The Master's Seminary (LA campus).
- 50 completed credit hours by the start of the Israel Trip in the M.Div. program. If we have scholarship funds left after December 4, 2024 (deadline for registration form and deposit), we will allow students with less than then 50 completed credit hours to submit a scholarship application for the trip scholarship.
- GPA above 2.5
- Completion of the scholarship application, including the file explaining why you would be a good recipient (see instructions below).

## How do you apply for a scholarship?

- 1. Complete the TMS Israel trip scholarship application by January 28, 2025, and submit the application and essay in person (to the seminary receptionist or Christine Dixon) or by email to Dr. Grisanti: <a href="mailto:mgrisanti@tms.edu">mgrisanti@tms.edu</a>.
- 2. Turn in the trip registration form and the trip deposit (\$500.00) to Christine Dixon by January 28, 2025. The scholarship recipients will be decided by February 3.

**Key:** *You will NOT be considered* for a trip scholarship unless you submit a registration form and deposit. If all other factors are equal, the date of your submitting the scholarship application, registration form, and deposit could be a factor in our decision on who receives a scholarship.

For those who will not have completed 50 credit hours by the end of the Spring 2025 semester, and you are seriously interested in going on the 2025 TMS Israel study trip, submit your registration form and deposit as well. However, only submit those items if you are *REALLY committed* to going on the trip if you receive a scholarship.

\*\*If a student not receiving this scholarship makes it impossible for them to go on the 2025 TMS Israel study trip, TMS will refund the trip deposit.

#### Clarification:

\*\*These scholarship funds are only for TMS students and not for their wives, as great as it is for a wife to join her husband for a trip like this.

Due date for the scholarship application and essay: Tuesday, January 28, 2025, before 4 p.m. to Dr. Grisanti (mgrisanti@tms.edu). Submit your deposit in person or mail to Christine Dixon and the registration form in person or via email to Christine Dixon: cdixon@tms.edu. You can also drop them off at the reception desk in an envelope with Christine's name on the envelope.

\*\*\*This money will NOT be deposited directly into your student account. It will go into the TMS Israel trip budget and your trip cost will be reduced by the amount of the scholarship.
