Payment Plan:

- Payment for the tour will be made online directly to "TUTKU Educational Travel."
- A deposit of \$200/person is due to TUTKU by December 1, 2025.
- The remaining **full payment** is due to TUTKU by March 1, 2026.
- For both payments, a link will be provided to make payment via secure credit card transaction.
- The \$100/person fee for administrative costs for non-TMS students/student-wives will be due in person at the start of the trip.

Refund Policy:

- The initial deposit of \$200 (due by December 1, 2025) is refundable until February 1, 2026.
- The remaining full payment is refundable after payment according to the following schedule:
 - o 89-60 days prior to departure: 100% refundable
 - o 59-45 days prior to departure: 75% refundable
 - o 44-30 days prior to departure: 50% refundable
 - o 29-15 days prior to departure: 25% refundable
 - O Within 14 days of departure: 0% refundable

Trip Insurance:
